Introduction

The role as Breast Nurse Specialist, is focused on running BreastCheck clinics in accordance with BreastHealth UK standards and protocols. BHUK provide BreastCheck services for Corporate clients at their chosen facility. You will be required to deliver education around Breast awareness and deliver individual one to one client services covering the below aspects:

- Review the Client's Personal Risk Assessment Score and discuss the results of this with the client (including Family History risk and Lifestyle recommendations)
- Discuss the BHUK recommended Personalised Breast Screening guidelines with the client
- Answer any related questions
- Teach breast awareness technique and how to self examine breasts

The employee handbook provides further guidance on other aspects of the employment.

You will report to the Clinical Lead – Breast, for any operational issues relating to your clinical practice and be accountable to the Clinical Services Director .

Clinical Practice

- To work in accordance with the standards of BreastHealth UK protocol for BreastCheck
- To respect client confidentiality at all times
- To work within the nursing team to maintain BreastCheck services
- To be accountable to NMC as per Code of Conduct
- To work within NMC Scope of Professional Practice
