## LungCheck

Lung cancer is the second most common cancer among men in the UK, and the third most common cancer among women. There are more than 46,000 lung cancers diagnosed each year in the UK.

80% of all lung cancers are directly or indirectly connected with smoking. There is no national screening programme for lung cancer, however, there are clinical trials evaluating low dose CT scans. CT scans are less specific than LungCheck and will identify a high number of people with abnormal results who do not actually have the disease (false positives).

### What is LungCheck?

LungCheck is a unique lung screening service comprising:

- An online symptomatic and risk assessment questionnaire
- A unique lung cancer specific blood test (EarlyCDT®-Lung)
- An at-home blood collection kit with pre-paid returns postage
- Personalised lung cancer screening programme
- Results letter within 2 weeks
- Referral for further assessment and investigation including a CT scan if results show to be abnormal

### When will the results be available?

Within 2 weeks of returning the sample, you will receive a results letter and a personalised early detection programme. We telephone anyone with an abnormal test result in advance of receiving their letter to explain their options and reduce any anxiety.

Should your test result be abnormal, you will be referred for a CT scan (included in the price of LungCheck). Should you have an abnormal CT scan result, you may be eligible for referral to a private consultant (if you have PMI, and your company has agreed to this policy beforehand) or to the NHS via your GP.

### Why will it benefit me?

The chances of survival from lung cancer are extremely good if detected early.

### Who will benefit

- Men and women aged 45+ who are current or past heavy smokers\*

\*20 pack year smoking history (a pack year is defined as one pack of cigarettes smoked per day for a period of one year, and so on)
